


Coyotes

Biology

- 20-45 pounds
- Look larger due to thick, heavy coat
- Generally shy, but may become habituated to human presence



Habitat



- Prairies, brushy areas and wooded edges are common habitat for a coyote.

- Dens

- Variety of locations
 - Brush-covered slopes
 - Steep banks
 - Hollow logs



- Home Range

- In the wild up to twenty square miles.
- In the City two to five square miles.

Predatory Behavior

- Coyotes prey on small mammals and birds.
- Most of the time they hunt for food alone.
- Eastern coyotes generally do not travel in packs; may be found in family groups with parents and young.



Activity



- Coyotes are most active at dawn and dusk.
- Coyotes can be active during day – this is not an indicator of a sick or dangerous animal!
- During the month of March & April Coyotes are active during the day hours so they can raise the offspring.

Population Structure

- Reproduction
 - Breeding Season Jan-March
 - Average litter size – 6
 - Raising offspring
 - Born helpless, blind
 - About ½ lb
 - Weaned 5-7 weeks
- Mortality
 - Maximum age 13-14 in wild
 - Average 1-4 years




Management of Coyotes

- Coyotes can be live-trapped in the city of Troy by properly licensed animal nuisance control companies.
- They also have to have an Animal nuisance business license (DBA) from Oakland County.
- A property owner can't trap unless they are properly licensed.

Attacks on pets



- More likely small pets that are allowed to roam free without supervision.
- Prevention key
 - Keep pets inside at night
 - Don't feed pets outside and remove extra food.
- Occurs less than commonly thought.

Preventing conflicts


- Never feed, approach or touch a coyote
- Eliminate all outside food sources, especially pet foods, bird seed, and garbage.
- Clear out wood and brush piles; they are good habitat for rats and mice which are a food source for coyotes
- “Haze” coyotes – make yourself look big – be noisy!
- Coyotes do not like the odor of ammonia or perfume. They do not like lights or sounds.


